

Attendance at Committee Meetings by Non-Members

Attendance at committee meetings is by invitation only.

The following persons, with the exceptions and conditions noted, are ordinarily invited to attend meetings of the following committees:

Audit

Assistant Principal (Resources).

Auditors have a right of attendance for business relevant to their remits.

Remuneration

Corporation members other than those appointed to membership of the Committee (with notice to the Chair of the Committee or Clerk to the Corporation), with the exception of staff and student nominee members who are not permitted to attend.

Others at invitation of Committee Chair.

The Principal (otherwise entitled to attend as an observer) shall be excluded from the Committee's consideration of her/his terms and conditions of employment.

Resources

Corporation members other than those appointed to membership of the Committee (with notice to the Chair of the Committee or Clerk to the Corporation), except that those persons who are members of the Audit Committee are not entitled to attend.

Deputy Principal.

Assistant Principals (Enterprise and Lifelong Learning, and Resources).

Others at invitation of Committee Chair.

Search

Corporation members other than those appointed to membership of the Committee (with notice to the Chair of the Committee), except that such observers shall not be permitted to attend the long-listing or short-listing of applicants for membership of the Corporation, interviews of prospective members of the Corporation (or Corporation members seeking re-appointment), deliberations relating to such interviews or to recommendations to the Corporation concerning appointments.

Others at invitation of Committee Chair.

Standards

Corporation members other than those appointed to membership of the Committee (with notice to the Chair of the Committee or Clerk to the Corporation).

Deputy Principal.

Assistant Principals.

Chair of Parents' and Friends' Association.

Chair of Student Council.

Others at invitation of Committee Chair.

There is no general right of attendance at committee meetings for members of the public.
